Pledge Drive For a Permanent Home for FAS

As those of you who have followed our adventure since the beginning in 2002 know, the sanctuary has been operating on rented property. Since it is not zoned for kennel purposes, the county limits the number of pets we can keep on premises. When we don't have enough foster homes to care for overflow pets, owners usually take them to county facilities where healthy animals are often euthanized.

Greatest Need & Greatest Opportunity

For years we've hoped to find affordable kennel property as a permanent home so we can save more pets' lives. Now, with so many foreclosed properties, more pets than ever have been abandoned. And now, more than ever, we might find affordable property zoned for kennel use.

We Need Your Pledge

Once we find the right property, we'll have to move quickly. We'll need about \$100,000 as a downpayment. To raise it quickly, we need to have a list of individuals and businesses we know we can count on for funding. To develop this list, we're introducing a Pledge Drive to recruit Charter Members of the FAS New Home Project. If just 100 Charter Members pledge one thousand dollars each, for example, we'll know we can be ready with the down payment! Some may be able to pledge more, some less. But we need to know how much you can set aside and pledge to write FAS a check within a 30 day notice if/when we find the right kennel-zoned property.

Become a Charter Member

To honor all those who make a new home possible, we will create a wall containing a plaque for each thousand dollar donor. Your plaque can contain your individual name, your family name and/or a beloved pet's name or inscription of your choice. We will also post a plaque listing names of those who donate under a thousand dollars. Those who donate over a thousand dollars may have specific buildings or areas on the property named after them as well. The details will be worked through once property is found.

FAS is the Only "No Kill" in Area

In the eight years since we started, FAS has saved over 3000 pets' lives. We have slowly but steadily progressed to where we can say we are here to stay. We are the only "No Kill" Sanctuary in our area. We desperately are needed in the Fallbrook, Rainbow and Bonsall areas.

We have an incredible crew of volunteers who have stuck with us since the start and they plan to stay. New dedicated volunteers have recently come aboard too and we will continue to welcome others to join us. All we need is a permanent home.

Donations Save Taxes & Save Lives

Of course we also need your donations to support ongoing costs. Since we are a 501(c)3, your donations are tax deductible. By donating to the Fallbrook Animal Sanctuary you are saving lives of pets and enriching (sometimes even saving) the lives of those who adopt them.

A few answers to questions you may have:

We have not yet found an appropriate, affordable kennel-zoned property. This pledge drive is in preparation for funding a downpayment once the property is found. We will NOT request a check for your pledge UNTIL we have found the property and are ready to make the offer. If you prefer to write a check now specifically for the FAS New Home Project, your check will be placed in a separate bank account set aside specifically for the FAS New Home Project and will not be used for FAS ongoing expenses. In the event you've given us your pledge check and the property sale is not completed, we will contact you. You can then decide if you would like your funds returned or if you'd like us to keep funds in the FAS New Home Project bank account for a certain period of time until we find another property. As always, the animals also need your checks for on-going monthly expenses. We will keep these funds separate.
